The ACHILLES project is carried out at the Faculty of Sport and Health Sciences. Our aim is to develop new methods to study the structure and loading of the Achilles tendon in health and injured participants.

The project includes several measurement protocols using novel ultrasound techniques, 3D motion capture, EMG, MRI and tensiometry. In addition, we will conduct a randomised controlled trial for tendinopathic patients starting in autumn 2024.
